There is unlimited entry for the races. Both races will be scored. The course will be same as the NCAA Division III Midwest Regional Cross Country Championships in November 2019.

Entries

Each team is allowed unlimited entries. Entries are done online through PT Timing: <u>www.pttiming.com</u>. Entries are due by Tuesday, October 15 at 7 p.m. (Central Time).

The entry fee will be \$35 plus fees per unattached or open athlete paid at an online registration site. Do not enter any unattached or open athlete on PT Timing.

Teams

We anticipate 35 NCAA Division III teams from just about every region and numerous other collegiate institutions from other divisions.

Entry Fee

The entry fee is \$200 per team, \$400 for both men and women. Teams that are not members of the USTFCCCA will have an entry fee of \$225 per team, \$450 for both men and women.

Course

The course will be the same for the 2019 NCAA Division III Midwest Regional Championship and the same as the 2018 NCAA Division III Championship. The terrain is basically flat with some slight, gradual grades. The highest elevation is located where the start merges with the large loop. The lowest elevations are at the start/finish and the 1-mile area. The footing is smooth and generally firm throughout the course. Three-eighth inch spikes are recommended. The course will be open on Friday, October 18 from 2 p.m. until dark (about 6 p.m.) for viewing.

Team Parking • Lake Breeze Golf Club

Team vehicles will enter Ball Prairie Road at Hwy 116, which is located just west off of Hwy 45.

Team vehicles will be directed to park at the gravel lot adjacent to the race course.

Please remind your athletes and coaches that spectator buses will be dropping off and picking up on the driveway into Lake Breeze Golf Club. This will be a busy area. Please be alert to the traffic.

Spectator Parking • Lake Breeze Golf Club

There is no spectator parking at the cross country course at Lake Breeze Golf Club. Spectator parking will be located at Winneconne High School at 100 Wolf Run, Winneconne, Wis. 54986.

Winneconne High School is located three miles from the cross country course. The shuttles will pick-up and drop-off spectators at the main entrance to the high school. Spectators should allow additional time to park and shuttle to the course.

Spectators must use Hwy 116 (Main Street) to N. 9th Avenue to access the parking lots at Winneconne High School. Uniformed patrols will monitor all access points to Lake Breeze Golf Club and the shuttle service to ensure this route for spectators.

Spectator shuttles are available to transport spectators for \$5 round trip. Anyone 5-years-old or younger is free. Handicap parking stalls and accessible shuttles will be available. The shuttle service will begin at 8 a.m. and conclude at 2:30 p.m. There are portable restrooms at the parking venue.

<u>Only participating team vehicles will park at the cross country course.</u> Any studentathlete who does not ride the team vehicle will have to pay to use the shuttle service.

Parents cannot drop off or pick up their son/daughter at Lake Breeze Golf Club or at the corner of Hwy 116 at Ball Prairie Road.

Any uniformed athlete accompanied by a paid spectator may take the shuttle bus back to Winneconne after his/her race.

No dogs, unless a service dog, or bikes are allowed on the shuttle service or at Lake Breeze Golf Club. Only service animals assisting an individual with a disability as defined by ADA are allowed.
