- Welcome to the Kettle Moraine D-1 Sectional. The WIAA Division-1 Sectional Cross Country meet will be held Saturday, October 26, 2019 at Naga-Waukee County Park in Delafield and is hosted by Kettle Moraine High School.
- The park is located ½ mile north of I-94 on highway 83. Take I-94, exit 287, (Wales exit) and take 83 north ½ mile and turn left into the park.
- Entries will be done on PT TIMING and are due at 11:59 PM ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- Coaches, please review the 2019 Sectional/State Tournament Information which is available on the WIAA Web Site. All entries are done through pttiming.com
- All athletes will be assigned chip numbers as well as bib numbers per WIAA regulations. If you have changes prior
  to the race, please see pttiming at the finish line area, as they are the timing company being used for this meet as
  well as the company responsible for all sectional entries.
- The course will be fully lined in open areas as well as flagged to help ensure a fair race for all athletes. Meet umpires will be on the course as well to help the athletes. Please remind your athletes the umpires are there to help ensure a fair race and not to look for issues, so let's not have any ©
