JURY OF APPEALS: Will consist of the WIAA appointed starter Glen Rauwerdink, Meet Manager Michael Bubolz, boys head coach-Sheboygan North, boys head coach-Oshkosh North, and girls head coach-Watertown.

Aurora/BayCare Sports Medicine Athletic Trainers will be on site at 9:30 am. The trainers will not be available to treat pre-existing injuries such as taping, etc.

Access to the clubhouse and bowling alley is prohibited.

Portable bathrooms will be provided for all athletes, coaches, and spectators.

There will be a concession stand located near the clubhouse.

Sectional long sleeve shirts will be sold and can be found near the concession stand.

Directions to Meadow Links: I-43 to exit 154 – (Hwy 310) go east and follow to Johnston Drive. Turn right on Johnston Drive.

BUS PARKING: Buses may park on Johnston Drive. Buses CAN NOT PARK in the Mall Parking Lot. Spectators should park in the neighboring streets. There is no bus or spectator parking in the Meadow Links Parking Lot.

TEAM TENT: Team tent area is along Johnston Dr between the street and the running course. Please do not set up within 25 meters of the start line.

CHIPS AND PACKETS: Upon arrival, please pick up timing chips and your meet packets at the finish line. At the conclusion of each race, a coach from each team must return the timing chips to the PT Timing truck located near the finish line.

RESTRICTED AREA: The flagged/roped off area around the PTTiming van and the finish line, the starting line, and the awards balcony. These areas are only for appropriate competing athletes and meet personnel.

AWARDS PRESENTATION will take place as soon as possible after the final race in the west parking lot/balcony area. D1 awards followed by D3 awards. We will recognize all State Meet qualifiers- the 2 top team finishers and the top 5 individuals not on those qualifying teams. After the awards, coaches of state qualifiers (teams and Individuals) are asked to pick up State Meet information at the awards area.
