

## **Menomonee Falls Cross Country**



## **Dear Coaches & Athletic Directors:**

The 25th annual JV State Invite is slated for Thursday, October 24, 2019 at Rotary Park in Menomonee Falls. This race is for all runners <u>not competing</u> at WIAA Sectionals on Saturday, Oct. 26, 2019.

<u>Directions:</u> To get to Rotary Park, take Menomonee Avenue from either Lilly Road (from the south only) or Pilgrim Road (from the north or south) to MacArthur Drive and the park is north. Buses can park along MacArthur Dr.

## **Entries:**

- PT Timing will provide chip timing for the meet again this year.
- After your conference meet has been run, submit your entries and <u>seed times</u> on the PTTiming registration website. Only non-sectional runners should compete.
- Use your runner's best time of the season. If you omit a seed time, the runner will automatically be entered in the faster race. There will be four races, two for boys and two for girls. The races will be divided into two (fast and faster) and PTTiming will determine the cut-off based on the number of entries.
- Deadline will be determined by PT timing, so check to see the final day entries are due and within 24 hours, they post the cut-off times between races. In the past, cut-off times for the boys has been around 20:30 and approximately 24:30 for girls.
- Coaches are responsible for the return of all chips for your team.

  There is a \$50 fee for lost chips!
- Return chips to PT Timing at the finish line upon the completion of the last race.

<u>Results</u>: Will be posted on the PT Timing website ASAP. As their procedure has been all year, PTT will not make hard copies of the race results available.

<u>Meet Schedule</u>: Race Date: Thursday, October 24, 2019-Note the different race schedule due to it getting darker sooner; no rain date scheduled.

2:15 p.m. Coaches may pick up chips at the finish line area.

3:15 p.m. Boys Faster race

3:45 p.m. Girls Faster race

4:15 p.m. Boys Fast race

4:45 p.m. Girls Fast race

Course Maps: A map for the 5K is included and also is posted on the Falls CC website.

Awards: We'll give out medals (top 10) and pumpkins (top 5) in the chute as the runners finish the race.
