Please list your 7 most likely runners as “VARSITY” on the PT Timing site. List 1-3 runners as alternates. Additions, changes or corrections can be made up until race time.

Timing & Scoring: PT Timing will be handling the timing and scoring for this event. A finish coral will be set up. Timing chips will be utilized with video backup.

Course: (map included & can also be found at www.southmilwaukeeccrosscountry.com)

The meet will take place in Grant Park. The course is mostly grass with the runners crossing the park roads and asphalt bike path several times. The course will be lined and flagged. The boy's distance will be 5,000 meters and the girl's distance will be 5,000 meters.

Time Schedule:

9:00 a.m. - Course open for warm-up

10:15 a.m. - Coaches meeting at the finish line

11:00 a.m. - Girl's race

11:45 a.m. - Boy's race

Awards presentation to follow

Restricted Areas:

Any area roped off by the finish line and the area 5 yards behind the starting line is restricted. This means that only competing athletes and meet personnel are allowed.

Trainer: A trainer will be located by the finish line.

State Qualifying:

Top two teams in each race and the first five individuals who are not members of a qualifying team.

Awards: The Awards presentation will take place by the finish line. Please have your athletes there to receive their award in proper attire.

Wireless Communication Devices:

The use of wireless communication devices (i.e., headsets, radios, cellular phones, etc.) except by meet management and meet officials is **PROHIBITED**.

Shoes: Spikes can be a maximum of 1/2" in length.

Misc: Please remind your athletes and fans of the following:

- 1.** No pets as per WIAA State Meet Policy.
- 2.** No footballs, frisbees, or soccer balls be brought to the park. Playing with these objects could interfere with the competition.

Directions to Course:

From the west – take I-94 east and follow signs towards the Milwaukee Airport (Mitchell Field). Get off on College Ave. Turn left (east) and go to Lake Drive (as far as you can go), turn right (south) and go to Park Ave. (first stop sign), turn left into park, stay on park road until the first road on your left. left turn, and take this road to parking lot.

From the north – take 894 east and follow signs towards the Milwaukee Airport (Mitchell Field). Get off on College Ave. Turn left (east) and go to Lake Drive (as far as you can go), turn right (south) and go to Park Ave. (first stop sign), turn left into park, stay on park road until the first road on your left. Turn left and take this road to parking lot.

It is very important that you remind your parents and fans that they may have to park on city streets if the parking lots in the park are full. This could happen as early as 10:15 am. It is much easier leaving the meet when you park on city streets. There is map on our website to help with city street parking. We will have signs on Lake Dr. to help parents & fan get to the starting line.
